
members which in turn creates a environment ready to grow and expand. A work cafe has been placed on the first floor drawing in much of the community thus creating free advertisement for the NEXT community.



DESIGN TEX- OPHIDIAN





## INFLUENCE OF RESEARCH:

### Palette of Postures:

Technology-- A key finding of the Steelcase posture study was that newer, smaller touch- based technologies (i.e., smartphones and tablets) are dramatically changing work postures.

Physiology-- Another influence that Steelcase researchers identified is changing workforce demographics.

Sociology-- With five generations now in the workplace, there is greater diversity in postural preferences, from casual reclined to formal upright...and everything in between.

## Fullest Value of Co-working:



## Individual and Collaborative Spaces:


