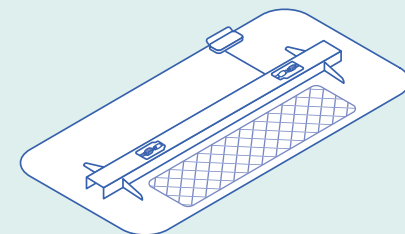


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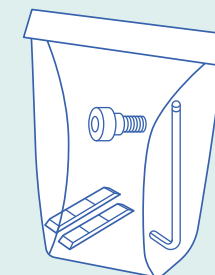
What's included

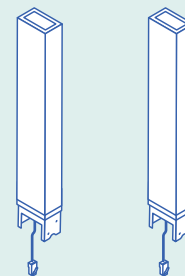

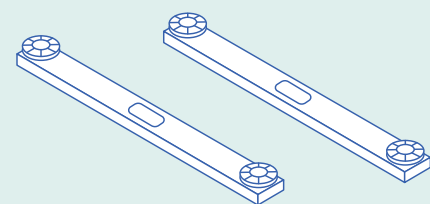

Some helpful tips

Pick a location where there is enough room between the desk and other nearby objects.

As you open the boxes, review the content and different elements. You can simply remove the cover off the large box and start the assembly process inside the open box.

Keep the worksurface adjustment range clear of obstructions.

Don't sit or stand all day. Both can take a toll on your body. Instead, try alternating between postures every 1-2 hours.

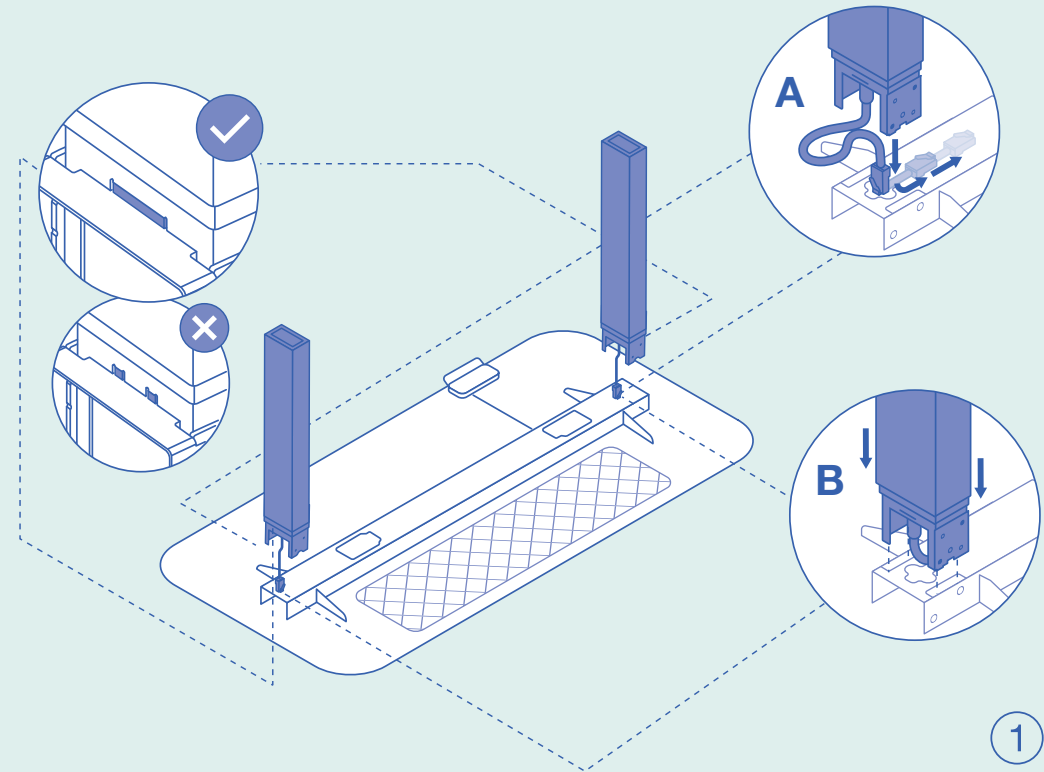

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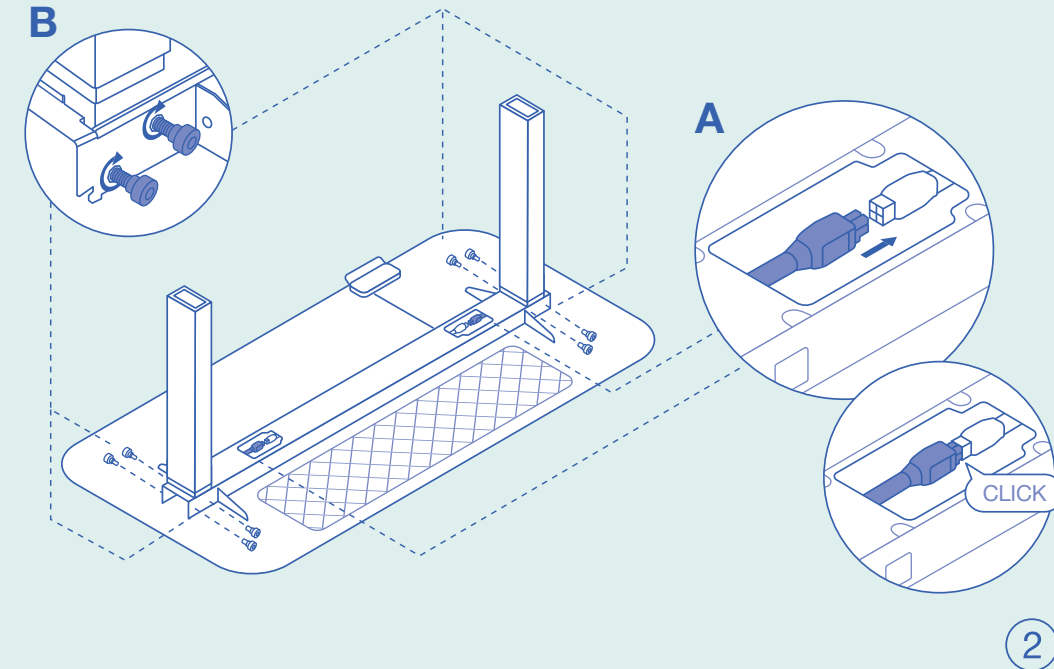
Attach the columns to the frame

Tip: Keep the top inside the packaging.
The right positioning of the columns is indicated through the little cut-outs on top of the column.



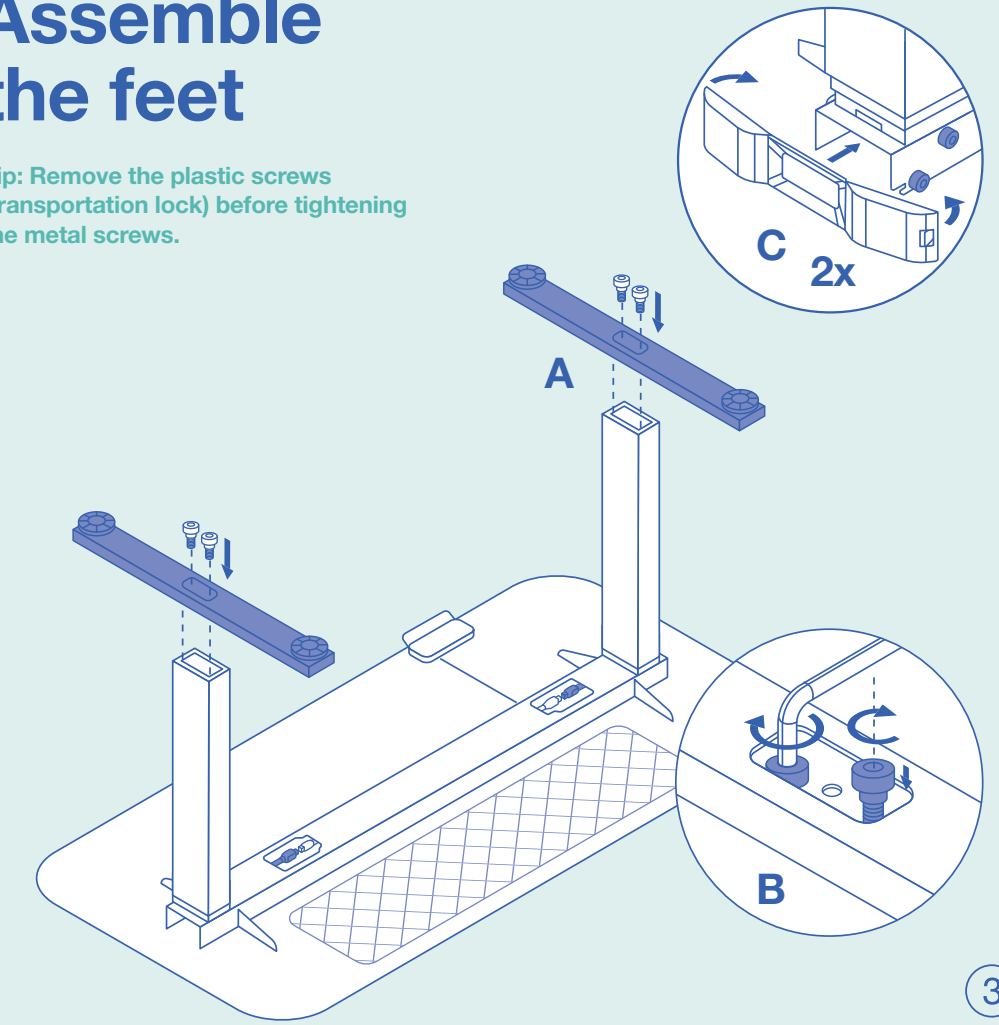
Connect the cables and tighten the screws

Tip: The cables are connected correctly when you hear a click sound. Make sure to tighten the screws tightly with the supplied tool, as that has a direct impact on the stability of the desk.



Assemble the feet

Tip: Remove the plastic screws (transportation lock) before tightening the metal screws.



Get to work

Flip the desk over, being cautious of the mounted switch on the underside. Adjust the levelling glides if needed, connect to power and you're done!
