Steelcase Education promotes active learning at scale at the 2017 ISTE Conference. Two educators share their insights on transforming education.

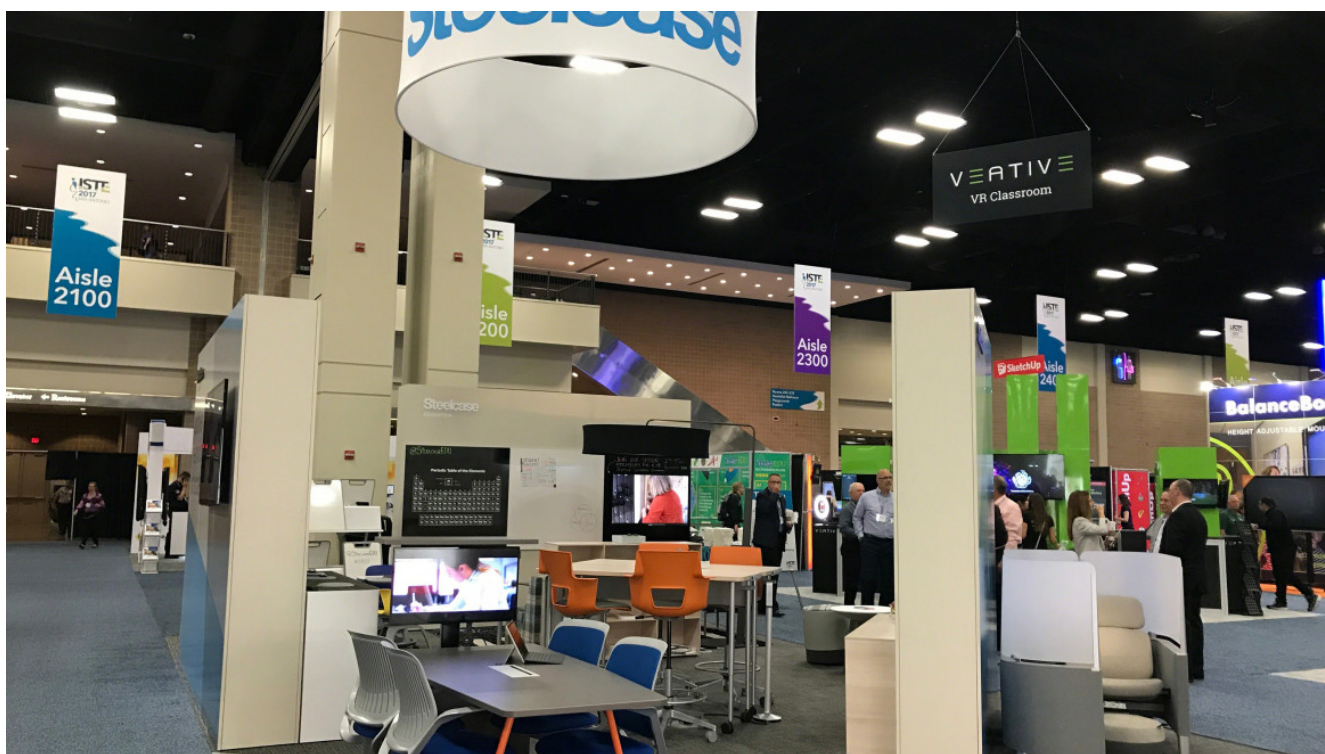
