

## **2005 Fourth Quarter Grant Awards**

The Steelcase Foundation awarded 12 grants to various organizations in its fourth quarter. The Foundation also matched \$64,593 in gifts to educational institutions, \$8,422 to arts and culture and \$1,075 to environment/conservation.
