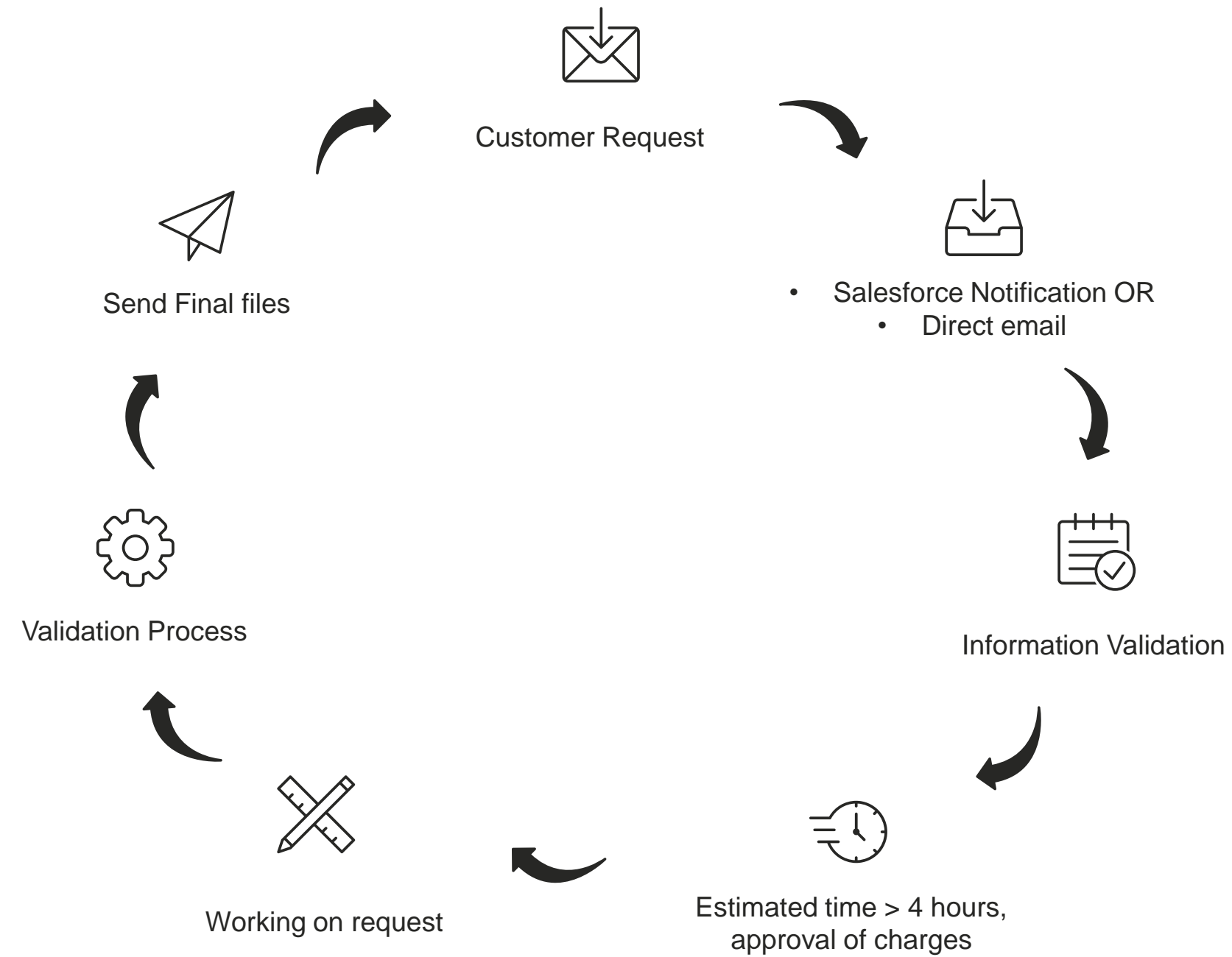


How to: Revit Translation

This document describes the process to request a Revit Translation via email. A service by Steelcase to create layout/typical/floor plans upon request.

Revit Inbox Workflow (revit@steelcase.com)



The information we need from the client is:

- The desired CET or Pcon file attached to translate to Revit
- Revit output .rvt or .rfa
- If materials must match the reference file

If the CET or Pcon file is estimated to take more than 4 hours, the client will be notified about the estimated time of completion and the charges.

We provide the first 4 hours of free service; each additional hour will have a charge of 50 USD per hour.

Once the client approves charges and shares a Cost Center (Steelcase accounts) or Billing information (External clients) we can start creating the files.
