The Evolving Library


For many higher education institutions, libraries have been the beating heart of their campus: a central, essential place for individual scholarship.

Over time, they've progressed into places where undergraduates, graduate students and faculty come together to learn, collaborate and engage in community.

External factors continue to place demands on libraries to support a variety of audiences and activities.


- · Students (and their parents) want exposure to relevant technologies and experiences.
- Learning is becoming more student driven with a mix of traditional, online and blended learning models. Faculty work involves different activities, pedagogies and tools than it has in the past.
- Businesses and communities are looking to leverage university resources to train and upskill adult learners.

As schools respond to these changing expectations, a new purpose has begun to emerge: the library as a vital resource center that connects students and faculty to one another, to librarians and to information.





The evolving library builds upon the functions and capabilities of traditional libraries.



Insights

In order to further understand how libraries and learning commons can better support users today and into the future, Steelcase performed a wide-ranging study of people and spaces across the country. Through a combination of campus visits, librarian and student interviews, an academic leaders roundtable, ethnographic observation, student-directed research and post-occupancy evaluation studies, four key insights were uncovered.





Libraries are a catalyst for evolution.

Libraries are expanding services and offerings as they move from being a place where people come only to research to a place they choose to visit because they feel more productive or want to be near friends and colleagues.

Libraries are interdisciplinary, inclusive + inspiring.

Serving the most diverse student bodies ever, libraries need to support immersive scholarship without feeling inaccessible. All users should find the library to be a safe neutral ground where everyone is a learner and even students can be teachers.

Libraries are at the intersection of scholarly, social + emotional needs.

Libraries are increasingly becoming a gathering spot where students can develop across multiple dimensions. In addition to building cognitive skills, students can practice personal and interpersonal skills such as resilience. collaboration, empathy and more. Additionally, libraries can support student wellbeing.

Libraries are adaptable, scholarly spaces that need to support a rhythm + range of learning.

There is a cadence to learning that shifts throughout the academic year, and libraries need to be able to flex to support a range of needs: focus and interaction, individual and group work, socializing and rejuvenation.

Design Principles

Libraries have traditionally been defined by the objects they held: books on shelves. More and more, they're being defined by the range of activities that happen inside them.

Steelcase identified three design principles that support the full range of student, faculty and community learning. These principles recognize that spaces best support people when they are designed as a holistic, integrated system, so it's important to leverage the entire floor plan as a connected system of learning environments.

Learning Commons Social Café

This learning commons café, placed at an intentional crossroad in the library, promotes planned and serendipitous encounters with peers and professors.



- 1 Open study tables create a casual space conducive to socializing and diffuse focus and study activities for individuals, small teams and larger project groups.
- 2 Shielded lounge areas allow for semi-private study or socializing for small groups.
- 3 A variety of chairs offers different seated and lounge postures; a mix of materiality adds personality in the space.
- 4 A nourishment bar and indoor plants create a respite space for getting coffee with others or taking a few minutes to reflect.

With easy access to colleagues, nourishment and places to rest the mind, people can restore brain energy and gain new perspectives.

- 3 A standing-height table with an open circulation path makes it easy to think and seamless to connect with ideas and project artifacts.




Makerspace + Fab Lab

This dedicated makerspace invites collaboration and facilitates easy transitions between the three creative behaviors: think, make and share.

- Open storage allows access to tools, equipment and prototyping materials. Different table heights promote multiple postures.
- Whiteboards and standing-height tables can be used to share ideas with peers, display prototypes, gather feedback, have new thoughts and prototype again.
- 3 The corner lounge area creates a respite space for diffuse attention and thinking. Users might read or write ideas on the paper-topped tables.





The creative process needs flexible spaces that can be arranged for formal presentations or informal sharing among peers or with faculty.

- 1 Flexible, easy-to-move seating supports stadium-style seating for larger-scale sharing.
- 2 Chairs are stackable when not in use. to allow for more open space. Benches are detachable and can be grouped in multiple ways.
- 3 A gallery along the back wall provides display space for student and faculty projects, from artwork to research posters.
- 4 Projection capabilities enable digital sharing, while whiteboards can be used for more organic and analog discussion.





Multipurpose Pitch + Gallery Space

This multipurpose pitch and gallery space emphasizes sharing behaviors in the creative process. Sharing can be informal or formal, depending on the need. The space can be used for larger groups and community gatherings, too.



- 4 Whiteboards create a sense of boundary and capture small group discussion and ideation.

In addition to the new experiences libraries are offering, there continues to be a need for serious, focused work and study.









- 3 Chairs with casters and swivel capabilities allow students to follow discussion, and maintain eye-to-eye contact, no matter where the instructor stands.
- 4 Lounge seating offers an alternative seating option with space for 1:1 or small group interaction before or after class.



- 4 A mobile cart for the instructor encourages healthy movement throughout class time, positioning the teacher as guide, rather than up-front lecturing; this layout allows discussion to be student-led.





- 1 A collaborative space with standingheight tables and stools can be easily configured for brainstorming, peer reviews or small group meetings.
- 2 Mobile digital displays and a variety of whiteboards and stands can be arranged to express ideas or create additional privacy.
- 3 Individual focus areas (which may be assigned or available for hoteling) include height-adjustable surfaces for longer work sessions.
- 4 High-density storage, which pulls out for additional shielding, offers a place for belongings and a perch for visitors.

Faculty and staff are being asked to work more collaboratively, and need spaces that encourage generative and evaluative work.

This space could function as a faculty office area or a department hub. A variety of settings gives users choice and control over where to work, based on the task at hand.






- 1 This area is zoned to promote interactions near the entrance, with quieter, more private zones in the back.
- 2 Storage in the lounge area also serves as space division. Boundary screens create additional privacy in the open plan.
- 3 Reservable enclaves offer acoustically private work spaces for focus and respite.
- 4 This collaborative standing-height table allows for impromptu meetings and serves as a place to touch down between meetings or classes.
